**GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR INTERNATIONAL SUBCONTRACTS/PURCHASE ORDERS FOR COMMERCIAL
ITEMS
UNDER A U.S. GOVERNMENT PRIME CONTRACT (ALL AGENCIES)**

1. ACCEPTANCE OF CONTRACT/TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(a) This Contract integrates, merges, and supersedes any prior offers, negotiations, and agreements concerning the subject matter hereof and constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.

(b) SELLER's acknowledgment, acceptance of payment, or commencement of performance, shall constitute SELLER's unqualified acceptance of this Contract.

(c) Unless expressly accepted in writing by LOCKHEED MARTIN, additional or differing terms or conditions proposed by SELLER or included in SELLER's acknowledgment are objected to by LOCKHEED MARTIN and have no effect.

(d) The headings used in this Contract are inserted for the convenience of the parties and shall not define, limit, or describe the scope or the intent of this Contract.

(e) This Contract shall be governed by the law of the United States and the federal common law of government contracts as enunciated in the Uniform Commercial Code, the Uniform Customs and Practice for International Contracts appeals, and quasi-judicial agencies of the federal Government. The Convention on Contracts for International Sale of Goods shall not apply.

(b) SELLER, in the performance of this Contract, shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and ordinances of the United States and the Contract. SELLER shall procure all licenses/permits, and pay all costs and expenses, with all applicable guidelines and directives of any local, state, and/or federal government, shall provide reasonable cooperation to LOCKHEED MARTIN in the nature and scope of any failure by SELLER or its personnel to comply with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances that may affect the performance of this Contract.

(c)(1) If: (i) LOCKHEED MARTIN's contract price or fee is reduced; (ii) any fines, penalties, or interest are assessed on LOCKHEED MARTIN; (iii) any other costs or damages; as a result of any violation of applicable laws, rules, regulations, and ordinances by SELLER, its officers, employees, agents, suppliers, or subcontractors, SELLER shall be liable for the amount of such costs or damages, as provided for in (2) below.

(2) Upon the occurrence of any of the circumstances, other than withholdings, identified in (1) above, LOCKHEED MARTIN may make a reduction of corresponding amounts (in whole or in part) in the price of this Contract or any other contract with SELLER, and/or may demand payment (in whole or in part) of the corresponding amounts.

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(b) "FAR" means the Federal Acquisition Regulation, issued as Chapter 1 of Title 48, Code of Federal Regulations.

(c) "Government" means the Government of the United States of America or any department or agency thereof.

(d) "LOCKHEED MARTIN" means LOCKHEED MARTIN CORPORATION, acting through its companies or business units as identified on the face of this Contract. If a subsidiary or affiliate of LOCKHEED MARTIN CORPORATION is identified on the face of this Contract, then "LOCKHEED MARTIN" means that subsidiary or affiliate.

(e) "LOCKHEED MARTIN Procurement Representative" means a person authorized by LOCKHEED MARTIN's cognizant procurement organization to administer and/or execute this Contract.

(f) "SELLER" means the party identified on the face of this Contract with whom LOCKHEED MARTIN is contracting.

(g) "Work" means all required labor, articles, materials, supplies, goods, and services constituting the subject matter of this Contract.

11. DISPUTES

(a) All disputes under this Contract that are not disposed of by mutual agreement may be decided by recourse to an action at law or in equity exclusively in a United States Court of competent jurisdiction located in the State from which this contract is issued. **Each party hereby irrevocably waives, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, any right it may have to a trial by jury in respect to any litigation direct or indirectly arising out of under or in connection with this Contract.**

(b) Until final resolution of any dispute, SELLER shall diligently proceed with the performance of this Contract as directed by LOCKHEED MARTIN.

12. ELECTRONIC CONTRACTING

The parties agree that if this Contract is transmitted electronically neither party shall contest the validity of this Contract, or any acknowledgement thereof, on the basis that this Contract or acknowledgement contains an electronic signature.

13. EXCUSABLE DELAY

(a) SELLER shall be excused from, and shall not be liable for, failure of performance to the extent due to causes beyond SELLER's control and without SELLER's fault or negligence, including, but not limited to, acts of God or public enemy, acts of Government in either sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather and delays of common carriers.

(b) In order to be excused from performance under (a) SELLER shall submit, within ten (10) calendar days of the start of the event causing delay, a written notice stating a complete and detailed description of such event, the date of commencement, an estimate of the probable period of delay, and explanation indicating how such event was beyond the control of SELLER and not due to its negligence or fault and what efforts SELLER will make to minimize the length of delay. SELLER shall submit within ten (10) calendar days of the end of the event a written notice stating the impact to the schedule and evidence justifying the length of the delay.

(c) If the delay extends for thirty (30) days or more this Contract may be terminated by LOCKHEED MARTIN without additional cost and without liability to SELLER.

16. FURNISHED PROPERTY (a) LOCKHEED MARTIN may, by SELLER's authorization, use by either LOCKHEED MARTIN or its customer (Furnished Property). Furnished Property shall be used only for the performance of this Contract. SELLER shall clearly mark (if this Contract is marked) all Furnished Property to show its ownership. (c) Except for reasonable wear and tear, SELLER shall be responsible for, any loss or damage to Furnished Property. Without additional charge, SELLER shall manage, maintain, and preserve the property in accordance with applicable law, the requirements of this Contract and good commercial practice. (d) At LOCKHEED MARTIN's request, and/or upon completion of the Work, SELLER shall return all Furnished Property to LOCKHEED MARTIN.

(a) through (d) above

17. GRATUITIES/KICKBACKS (a) SELLER shall not offer or give a kickback or gratuity (in the form of entertainment, gifts, or other favors) to any Lockheed Martin employee, agent, or representative. SELLER certifies and represents that it has not made or solicited and will not make or solicit any such gratuity or kickback.

(b) SELLER shall not enter into any arrangement with any Lockheed Martin employee, agent, or representative (located in the United States.) (a) SELLER understands that the Work may be, either now or in the future, subject to one or more trade remedy laws, including but not limited to the Anti-Corruption Laws of the United States.



(c) Unless this Contract expressly states that LOCKHEED MARTIN is designated as the importer of record, SELLER agrees that:

(1) LOCKHEED MARTIN will not be a party to the importation of Works, the transaction(s) represented by this Contract will be consummated after importation, and SELLER shall neither cause nor permit LOCKHEED MARTIN's name to be shown as "Importer Of Record" on any customs declaration Temporary or Import Bond; and

(2) Upon request and where applicable, SELLER shall provide to LOCKHEED MARTIN Customs Form 7501 entitled "Customs Entry", properly executed.

19. INDEMNITY

SELLER shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless LOCKHEED MARTIN, its officers, directors, employees, consultants, agents, affiliates, successors, permitted assigns and customers from and against all losses, costs, claims, causes of action, damages, liabilities, and expenses, including attorney's fees, all expenses of litigation and/or settlement, and court costs, arising from any act or omission of SELLER, its officers, employees, agents, suppliers, or subcontractors at any tier, in the performance of any of its obligations under this Contract.

20. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR RELATIONSHIP

SELLER is an independent contractor in all its operations and activities hereunder. The employees used by SELLER to perform Work under this Contract shall be SELLER's employees exclusively without any relation whatsoever to LOCKHEED MARTIN.

21. INFORMATION OF LOCKHEED MARTIN

(a) Information provided by LOCKHEED MARTIN to SELLER remains the property of LOCKHEED MARTIN. SELLER shall comply with the terms of any proprietary information agreement with LOCKHEED MARTIN and comply with all proprietary information markings and restrictive legends applied by LOCKHEED MARTIN to anything provided hereunder to SELLER. SELLER shall not use any LOCKHEED MARTIN provided information for any purpose except to perform this Contract and shall not disclose such information to third parties without the prior written consent of LOCKHEED MARTIN. SELLER shall maintain data protection processes and systems sufficient to adequately protect LOCKHEED MARTIN provided information and comply with any law or regulation applicable to such information.

(b) If SELLER becomes aware of any compromise of information provided by LOCKHEED MARTIN to SELLER, its officers, employees, agents, suppliers, or subcontractors (an "Incident"), SELLER shall take appropriate immediate actions to investigate and contain the Incident and any associated risks, including prompt notification to LOCKHEED MARTIN after learning of the Incident. As used in this Section, "compromise" means that any information provided by LOCKHEED MARTIN has been exposed to unauthorized access, inadvertent disclosure, known misuse, loss, destruction, or alteration other than as required to perform the Work. SELLER shall provide reasonable cooperation to LOCKHEED MARTIN in conducting any investigation regarding the nature and scope of any Incident. Any costs incurred in investigating or remedying Incidents shall be borne by SELLER.

(c) Any LOCKHEED MARTIN provided information identified as proprietary or subject to restrictions on public disclosure by law or regulation shall be encrypted (i) if transmitted via the Internet, or (ii) during electronic storage if potentially accessible by the Internet or otherwise by non-authorized users.

(d) The provisions set forth above are in addition to and do not alter, change or supersede any obligations contained in a proprietary information agreement between the parties.

(e) Unclassified controlled DoD information shall be governed by DFARS 252.204-

29. PACKING AND SHIPMENT

(a) Unless otherwise specified, all Work is to be packed in accordance with good commercial practice.

(b) A complete packing list shall be enclosed with all shipments. SELLER shall mark containers or packages with necessary lifting, loading, and shipping information, including the LOCKHEED MARTIN Contract number, item number, dates of shipment, and the names

maximum per diem rate in effect at the time of travel, as set forth in the United States Federal Travel Regulations for the area of travel authorized under this Contract. Air travel shall be reimbursed for coach class only. Lodging expenses are reimbursable only where incurred from establishments serving the general public.

(c) SELLER shall provide a detailed summary of all such costs by category of expense with each invoice. SELLER shall provide a legible receipt for each claimed individual expense exceeding \$75.00.

42. UNITED STATES CUSTOMS-TRADE PARTNERSHIP AGAINST TERRORISM (C-TPAT)

(a) This clause only applies to

44. WAIVERS, APPROVALS, AND REMEDIES

(a) Failure by either party to enforce any of the provisions of this Contract or applicable law shall not constitute a waiver of the requirements of such provisions or law, or as a waiver of the right of a party thereafter to enforce such provision or law.

(b) LOCKHEED MARTIN's approval of documents shall not relieve SELLER of its obligation to comply with the requirements of this Contract.

(c) The rights and remedies of either party in this Contract are cumulative and in addition to any other rights and remedies provided by law or in equity.

45. WARRANTY

SELLER warrants that all Work furnished pursuant to this Contract shall strictly conform to applicable specifications, drawings, samples, descriptions, and other requirements of this Contract and be free from defects in design, material, and workmanship. This warranty shall begin upon final acceptance and extend for a period of one (1) year. If any nonconforming Work is identified within the warranty period, SELLER, at LOCKHEED MARTIN's option, shall promptly repair, replace, or reperform the Work. Transportation of replacement Work, return of nonconforming Work, and reperformance of Work shall be at SELLER's expense. If repair, or replacement, or reperformance of Work is not timely, LOCKHEED MARTIN may elect to return, reperform, repair, replace, or repro cure the non-conforming Work at SELLER's expense. All warranties shall run to LOCKHEED MARTIN and its customers.

46. WORK ON LOCKHEED MARTIN AND THIRD PARTY PREMISES
